

DSMA Softball: Frequently Asked Questions

CAN I GET MY MONEY BACK IF I DROP OUT?

If you sign up for a league and then decide to withdraw from the league, the DSMA will retain \$25.00 from your entry fee and refund the remaining \$370.00 if you withdraw within five (5) business days after registering. If you withdraw after five business days, the DSMA will retain the entire entry fee.

WHEN WILL LEAGUE SCHEDULES COME OUT?

League play will begin Sunday, March 20, 2011. League schedules will be posted on www.dsma.com approximately one week before your first game. **Schedules will not be mailed. If you do not have access to the website make sure you designate someone on your team to do that checking.**

WHAT OFFICIAL SOFTBALL DO WE USE?

DSMA will provide all game balls for league and playoff games. Men and Coed-Men will hit a 12" ball, ASA-approved (.cor 44). Coed-Women will hit an 11" ball, ASA-approved (.cor 44). Balls will be optic yellow.

WHEN DO I GET A ROSTER AND WHEN IS IT DUE?

Roster forms are included in your registration packet or may be downloaded from our website at www.dsma.com. **A roster must be turned in to your scorekeeper on the FIRST NIGHT OF LEAGUE PLAY. If any changes are made from your first roster, then final rosters must be turned in to the Athletic/Reservations Office or the Kiest Softball Complex no later than Monday, April 18, 2011.** Rosters may be turned in to your scorekeeper *only* on your first league night.

WHAT ARE SOME OTHER THINGS I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT LEAGUE?

- All bats on the **ASA or USSSA** 2010 approved bat lists are legal in **all DSMA leagues.**
- All make-up games will be scheduled on your normal league night, usually following the end of the season or in open time slots (e.g. 9:45).
- All league winners receive a team trophy and a set of 15 championship t-shirts.
- All league winners receive a free entry to the City Playoffs for their classification. Any other eligible DSMA team may enter for a \$125 fee.
- Each player's shirt **must** have a number; permanent numbers are preferred, but tape or markers may be used on a temporary basis.
- Line-up cards may be obtained from the scorekeeper at the field.
- Batters will come to the plate with a count of "1 ball and 1 strike"; the batter will have up to 3 more balls and/or 2 strikes to complete their at bat. **Coed Class D leagues will be allowed an extra foul ball; Men's C/D, Coed C/D and Men's D leagues do not get an extra foul.**
- BASE STEALING is allowed in all Men's leagues. Please see Constitution & By-laws for rules.

HOW CAN I RESERVE A FIELD FOR PRACTICE?

Reservations can be made on City of Dallas fields by opening a reservation account at the Athletic/Reservations Office. Evening reservations are \$50 for one hour (beginning at 7:00 pm); daytime reservations are \$25 for one hour. Call the Reservations Office at 214.670.8740 for more information.
